NASHUA - This week Rivier University announced that a new dean, Dr. Susan Langlois, will oversee the Division of Arts and Sciences, which includes the natural and social sciences, humanities, and mathematics and computer science departments.

Langlois previously held the position of Dean of Academic Affairs and Student Services at Marian Court College. Other experience includes administrative and faculty positions at Springfield College, Endicott College and Elms College.
