

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Frequently asked questions about services and required health forms at the office of Quibin Student Health Services, Rivier University.

- **What does a student do if he/she is not able to secure an appointment with their primary care provider for exam/immunizations verification until after the health forms are due?** We will accept last year's physical exams with the most up-to-date list of immunizations. The student can bring in the updated physical exam or any other forms with them after their new appointment. The student's primary care provider may fax forms to us at: (603)897-8806.
- **Are flu vaccines generally available on or near campus?** Yes. Health Services sponsors a flu vaccine clinic in the fall for students, and the University has a campus-wide flu vaccine clinic each year. There will be a fee for the vaccine, unless the student's health insurance covers the cost of the vaccine. We communicate our upcoming flu vaccine clinics by email, posters and the Health Services Facebook page. Rite Aid and Walgreens, pharmacies that are both located close to campus, also have flu vaccine available through most of the flu season each year.

- **Are medical lab services available at Health Services and what is the cost?** For resident students, the following lab tests are available at no cost: rapid strep test, rapid mono test, reagent strips for urinalysis, blood glucose, and pregnancy tests. If we have to send out a lab test, such as a throat or urine culture to Quest Labs, the student's health insurance will be billed for the test.
- **What if a student needs a referral for physical therapy, or to a local medical specialist?** We will work with the student to help find services that are close to campus and convenient for the student.
- **Does a student need an appointment to be seen in Health Services?** To help ensure that students are given adequate time for their appointment, we do recommend students call ahead (603) 897-8295, email healthservices@rivier.edu , or sign up in person for an appointment.
